Background:

The Friends are a non-profit corporation formed in 1961 and recognized as a public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code in 1997. The Friends support the Library through fundraising, advocacy and volunteer activities. The Board of Directors sets policies, manages Friends' initiatives, and appoints new members. Directors serve a three-year term and may be reappointed.

Duties of the Directors:

- ◆ Attend and participate in regular and special Board meetings. (Regular Board meetings are held on the second Tuesday of most months).
- ◆ Vote on all motions presented to the Board. Authorize disbursements and necessary expenditures. Elect the officers of the organization.
- ◆ Participate in various events sponsored by the Friends. These include the Annual Fund Drive, Annual Meeting and Community Day.
- ◆ Participate in advocacy activities that encourage both the public and elected officials to support the Library in its mission as the community resource for education, exploration, enrichment and enjoyment.
