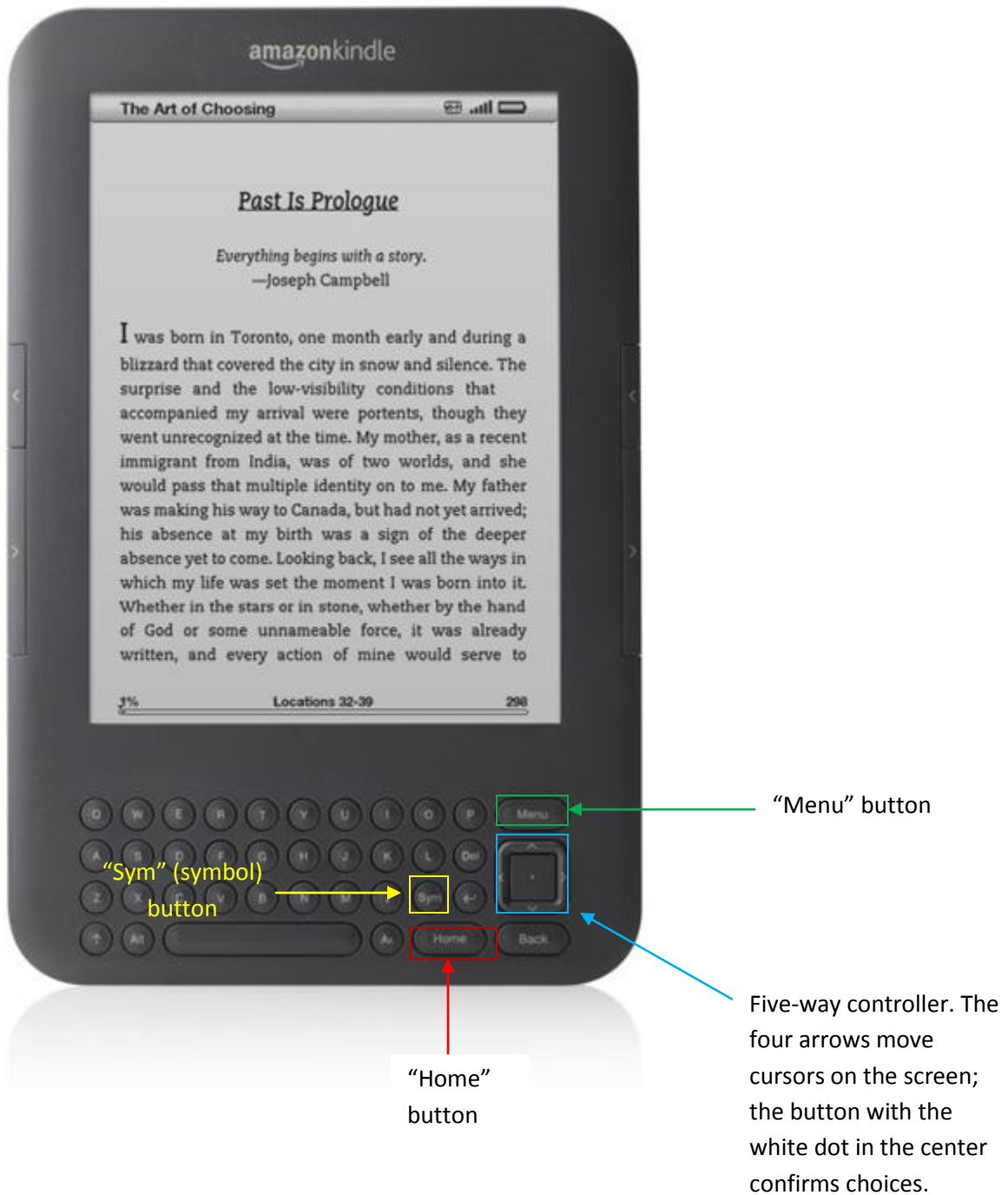


## How to Access Library WiFi with an Amazon Kindle



Amazon Kindles now work with OverDrive! It is possible to use the Library's Internet connection on WiFi-capable Kindles to use WhisperSync to download borrowed library eBooks after the entire checkout/Amazon sync process has occurred on a public computer. Here's how to access WiFi with your Kindle at your Library (please refer to the image above to see where all of the buttons are located):

1. Press the "Home" button.
2. A screen will load that lists items stored on the Kindle. Press the "Menu" button. A menu box will appear on the right side of the screen. The top line should say "Turn Wireless Off" (if it does not, see the note below\*). "Shop in Kindle Store" should be underlined by default. Press the five-way controller center.
3. Since the Kindle is not yet connected to the Library's WiFi network, a screen will appear that lists available networks, and should include the Library's. Use the five-way controller's arrows to highlight the word "Connect" next to the Library's network, and press the five-way controller center to confirm. (Please note that this is the quickest way to gain access to a WiFi connection; you can also access the wireless Internet setup under the "Settings" option in the Menu screen.)
4. A screen that says "Sign-in Required" will appear. "Go to Browser" should already be highlighted; press the five-way controller center to continue.
5. The browser will open and show the familiar CLP logo and blank library account number field. This may vary for ACLA libraries. Use the five-way controller arrows to move the cursor into the number field. It might take a few tries to get the cursor in the right place; you should see a "|" style cursor appear when it's in the field correctly, and a hand with a finger pointing up into the box.
6. Press the "Sym" button. It will open a box of numbers and symbols on the Kindle screen. Use the five-way controller arrows and center to enter in the patron's library card number. Press "Sym" again to exit the symbol box. Use the five-way controller arrows to move the cursor down one space to the "Submit" button on the screen; you should again see the hand with a finger pointing up at the button. Press the five-way controller center to submit the number.
7. The CLP homepage will open up. Again, this may vary across ACLA libraries. Press the "Menu" button again. The option "Enter URL" is available for Web browsing, and "Shop in Kindle Store" will now allow access. Choose either one by using the five-way controller arrows and center.
8. To sync Library ebooks, press "Home" to access the home page. Then press "Menu." Using the five-way controller, scroll down four spaces to "Sync & Check for Items." Press the center of the five-way controller, and the Kindle will download any OverDrive ebooks that have been directed to the device.

\*If Wireless is turned off on the Kindle, the top line of the menu box will read "Turn Wireless On." To do so, press the five-way controller "up" arrow once so "Turn Wireless On" is underlined. Then press the five-way controller center. This will turn the Kindle's wireless on, and the menu screen will disappear. When you press the "Menu" button again, the top line should read "Turn Wireless Off." Continue with Step 2.
