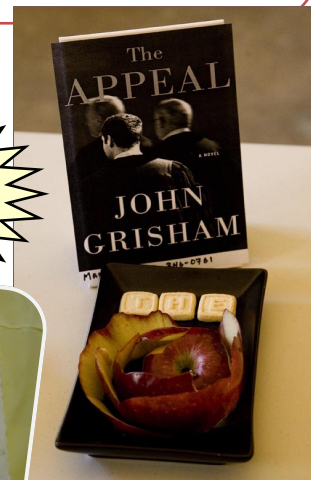
## What is an Edible Book Festival?

## Edible Book Rules

- ▶ Each edible creation must depict a fictional or non-fictional literary work, character, or theme.
- ▶ Each entry must be edible. (Small inedible objects may be used as a garnish.)
- ▶ The entry form can be picked up at the Whitehall Public Library or downloaded from our website at: [www.whitehallpubliclibrary.org](http://www.whitehallpubliclibrary.org). **Forms must be submitted to the library by Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**
- ▶ Entrants must agree to grant the library permission to photograph and publish information on edible creations, both in print and the internet.
- ▶ The edible creation must be delivered to the Whitehall Public Library (Community Room) on **Saturday, April 13, 2019 between 9:30 AM - 10:30 AM.** Prizes will be awarded at the event's conclusion at **1 PM.** Entries will not be eaten as part of the event, and contestants may take their entries home when they leave the event.
- ▶ Entries will be judged and prizes awarded for the following categories:
  - ◆ Best In Show - Adult / Teen / Child (Judges' favorite)
  - ◆ Most Clever/Creative
  - ◆ Most Realistic (Closest to actual book)
  - ◆ People's Choice Award - Adult and Youth

NOTE: All entries must be "family-friendly". The library reserves the right to reject any entries that are considered to be inappropriate.
