

March 6: Dark Waters (126 Minutes)



March 13: Bombshell (109 Minutes)

March 20: Richard Jewell (131 Minutes)

Directed by Clint Eastwood and based on true events, this is a story of what happens when what is reported as fact obscures the truth. "There is a bomb in Centennial Park. You have thirty minutes."
