[Homeless Services \(Emergency Shelter Listing & Drop-In/Engagement Center Listings\)](#)

Allegheny County offers a wide array of housing options and services for people experiencing or at risk of homelessness, including: emergency shelter, permanent housing and supportive services; street outreach, engagement and case management; and prevention strategies. Over 30 agencies provide approximately 120 programs to meet the diverse needs of individuals and families in a housing crisis. Services are accessed through the county's coordinated entry system (the Allegheny Link).

[Housing Navigator Unit for Everyone](#)

The Department of Human Services Housing Navigator Unit was established in 2018 to help homeless persons served by DHS find and maintain safe, affordable housing in the private market. The Housing Navigator Unit works toward this goal by recruiting and supporting landlords in the private market who rent to DHS tenants. The unit also works with the agencies charged with providing support services to the tenants. This public/private partnership aims to speed up access to private rental properties, improve communication and trust, resolve concerns and complaints, and increase accountability among all parties - the landlords, the service providers and the tenants.
